



Covid Precautions Guidance for Village Hall Reopening May 2021 rev A

From: 17 May

- Controlled indoor events can take place with up to 50% capacity of the Hall.
- Six people or two households will be allowed to gather in groups but must not mix with other groups and must maintain social distancing between groups. This will constrain the total capacity of to approximately 48 people.
- Windows and doors should be kept open and the entrance and exits used as indicated.
- Film shows, plays, concerts and sports matches can take place, subject to social distancing as above.
- Indoor sports activities, including exercise classes, table tennis, badminton can take place.
- Up to 30 people will be able to attend weddings, receptions, funerals, and wakes.
- Organised outdoor entertainment can take place.
- The "rule of six" will be abolished for outdoor gatherings, replaced with a limit of 30 people.
- Users will be required to submit a risk assessment for approval of the Hall Management Committee before proceeding with their event. Sample risk assessments will be provided.
- PPE, hand sanitizing and social distancing guidance notices are provided. Users are requested to restrict use of the toilet facilities to one person at a time.

From: 19th July

- All legal limits on social contact are removed.
- Outdoor events with more than 30 people can take place.
- Dancing is permitted.
- Restrictions on numbers at weddings and funerals are abolished.
